## **Membership Programs**

### **Blue Honor Key Club**

- Lifetime Invitation to anyone who earns BHK
- Exclusive events, Exclusive Merchandise and Social Media/Event Recognition for those who earn their BHK
- Those who earn their FMA earn a one time invitation to a BHK event
- Anyone who earns the Merlin E. Meredith Top Recruiter award is Grandfathered into the program

- Must Qualify by November 30th for January event, March 31st for June event
- First event in January, Second in June
- Cover heavily on social media to incentivise those who are close to push towards that goal
- (Work on Masonic Sponsor for Program)

## **Traveling Shield**

- Start Shield at smaller chapter to encourage chapters to travel outside of district
- Notebook travels with shield to log who has had it and for how long
- Chapter must bring at least 2 Active DeMolays and 1 Advisor to Steal Shield
- Shield MUST be stolen at stated meeting or Initiation(No Installations)

-If Shield remains at chapter for 2 stated meetings, the chapter who holds it is encouraged to present shield to another chapter of their choosing

-If chapter is unable to do so, The district Rep for the district the chapter is in will retrieve it and present it to another chapter of their choosing(not their own)

## **Chapter Of Excellence**

**A program to incentivise proper chapter operations, Attendance at state functions, traveling outside the chapter, and ritual**

**-A chapter who meets the minimum requirements will be declared an Ohio DeMolay Chapter of Excellence and be presented a plaque at conclave 2024**

**-The chapter that meets the minimum requirements while earning the most points will be named Chapter of the Year 2023-2024 and**

**awarded a special recognition to be displayed at their chapter**

## **How to Earn Points**

- Participate in State Bowling Tournament(50)**

- Official visit to another chapter with a minimum of 2 DeMolays and 1 Advisor(10)**



- Chapter represented at Conclave(100)
- Chapter represented at Winterfest(50)

- Advisory Council registration before October 1st(50) (Half points if before November 30th)
- Form 10 submitted on time(5)
